

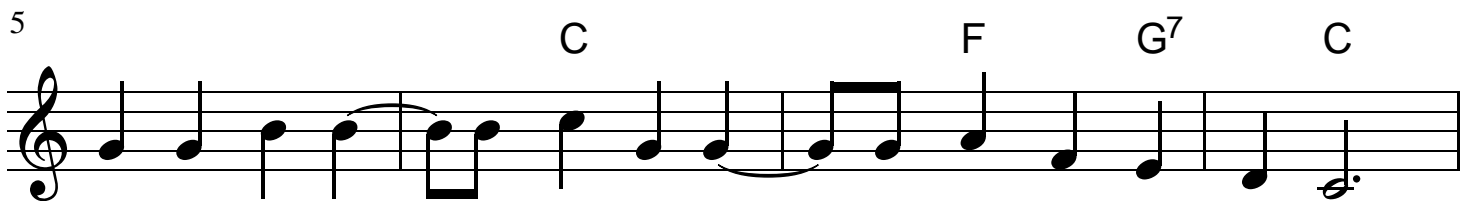
# The Happy Wanderer

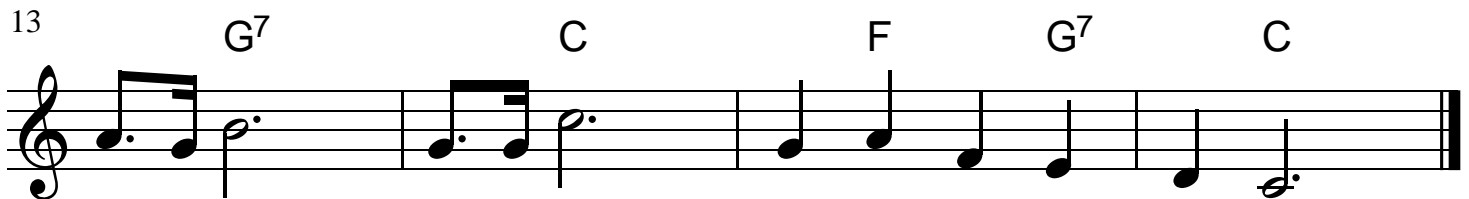
1. I love to go a wan - der - ing, a - long the moun - tain track,
